3rd Stewardess



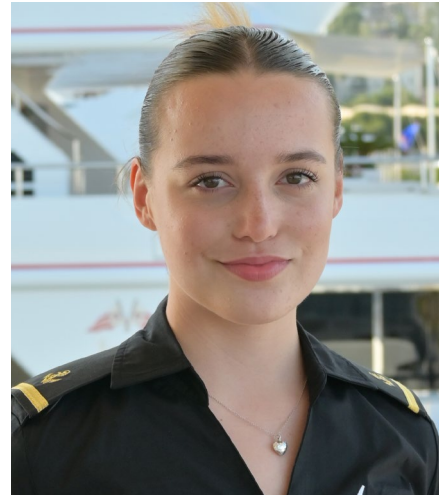
Marna attended high school in South Africa but completed her university studies in the USA.
